Annual Report to the Membership, 2006

Board of Directors:

Mary Wallace Davidson, President; Jane Gottlieb, Past President; Robert Acker, Secretary and Webmaster; Mary Alice Fields, Treasurer; Barbara Mackenzie, and Alan A. Green, Members-at-Large. *Ex officio*: James P. Cassaro (IAML Vice-President) and John H. Roberts (IAML Past President).

The Board met twice, in Memphis in February and in Göteborg, Sweden in June. Discussions focused on stewardship of financial resources and increasing visibility of IAML-US, as well as its membership. Travel grants to the Göteborg (Sweden) meeting were not awarded due to lack of funds. However Jim Cassaro, Barbara Mackenzie, and John Roberts volunteered to develop guidelines for how funds from the Lenore Coral Travel Grant might be administered.

Annual meeting:

Membership:

On Nov. 15, 2006, the membership stood at 79 personal and 130 institutional. The previous year ended at 77 and 117, respectively. In April 17 members, who had not paid dues since 2003, were removed from the rolls. In December reminders were sent by e-mail to 19 individuals whose memberships had lapsed since then.

- The relationship established in June 2003 with A-R Editions of Madison, Wisconsin for assistance with member and subscriber services is serving us well. They have suggested cost-effective improvements in some procedures.
- The Donated Materials Program continues under the able leadership of Marjorie Hassen, The sponsorship of Naxos Digital's provision of limited access to the music library of the Jagiellonian University in Krakow was so successful that Stanisław Hrabia has begun negotiating with Naxos for another subscription.
